Speeding up procedures and reducing complexity



- REDII provisions on the maximum duration of procedures
- Good practices from MS transposition of the Directive

- REDII provisions on the one-stop-shop
- Good practices from MS transposition of the Directive

 - Positive silence under certain conditions
 - Digital tools and procedures

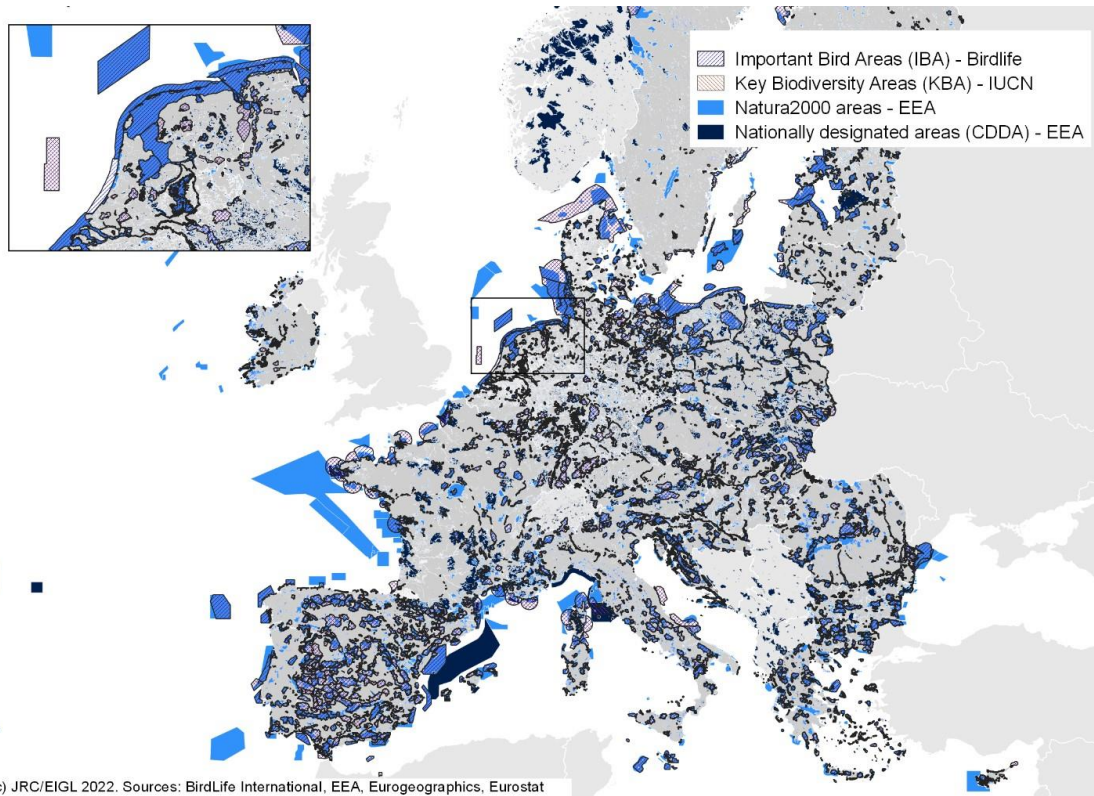
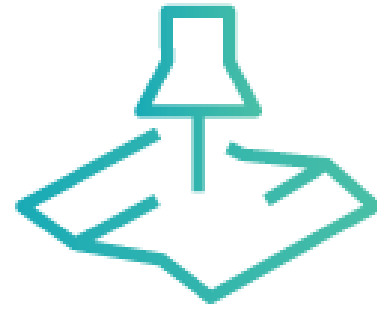
Sufficient human resources and skills

- Addressing the skills gaps

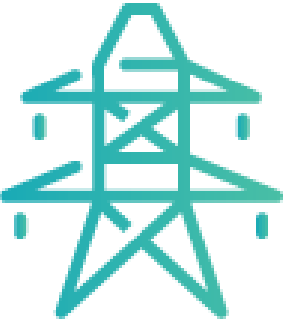
