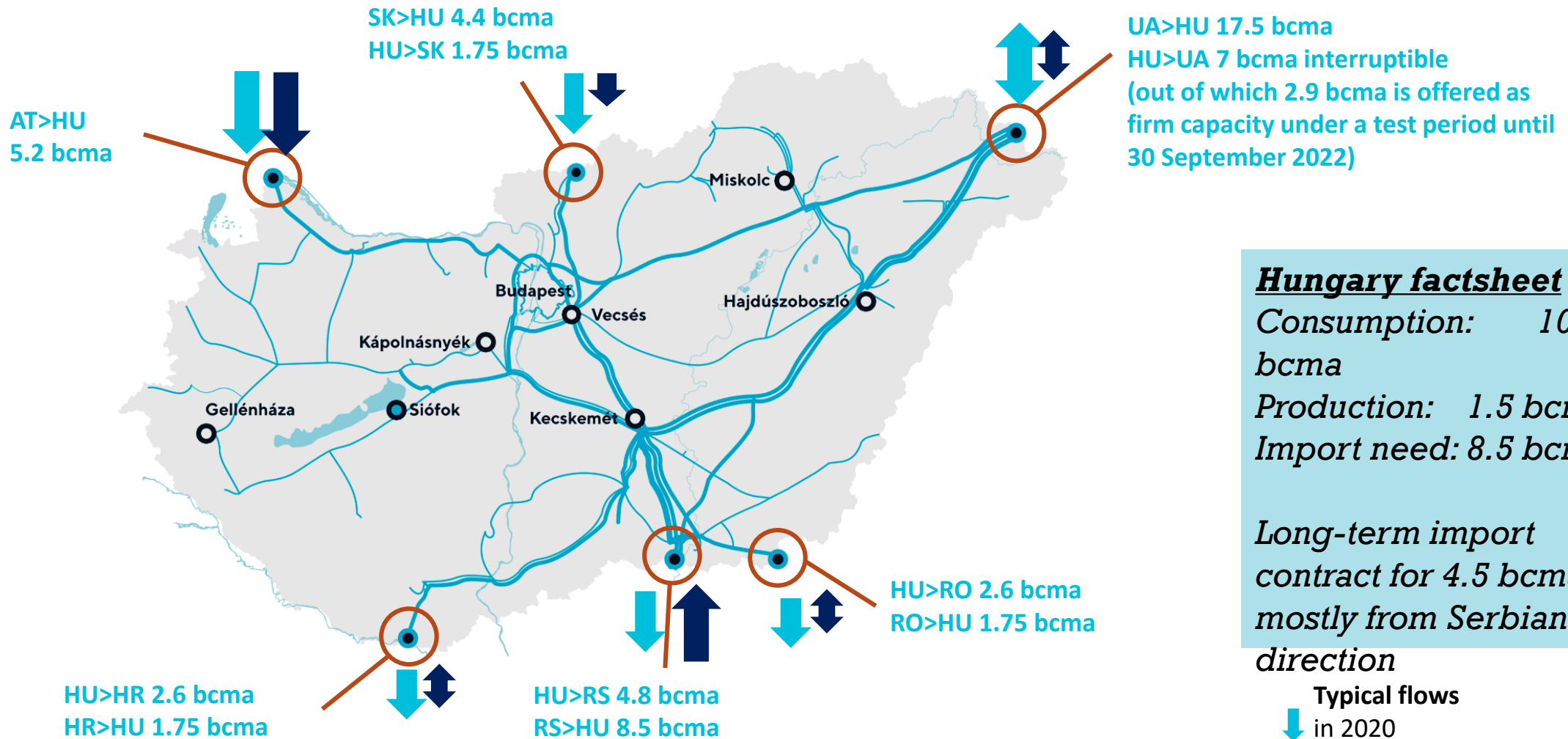


Hungary's existing cross-border capacities

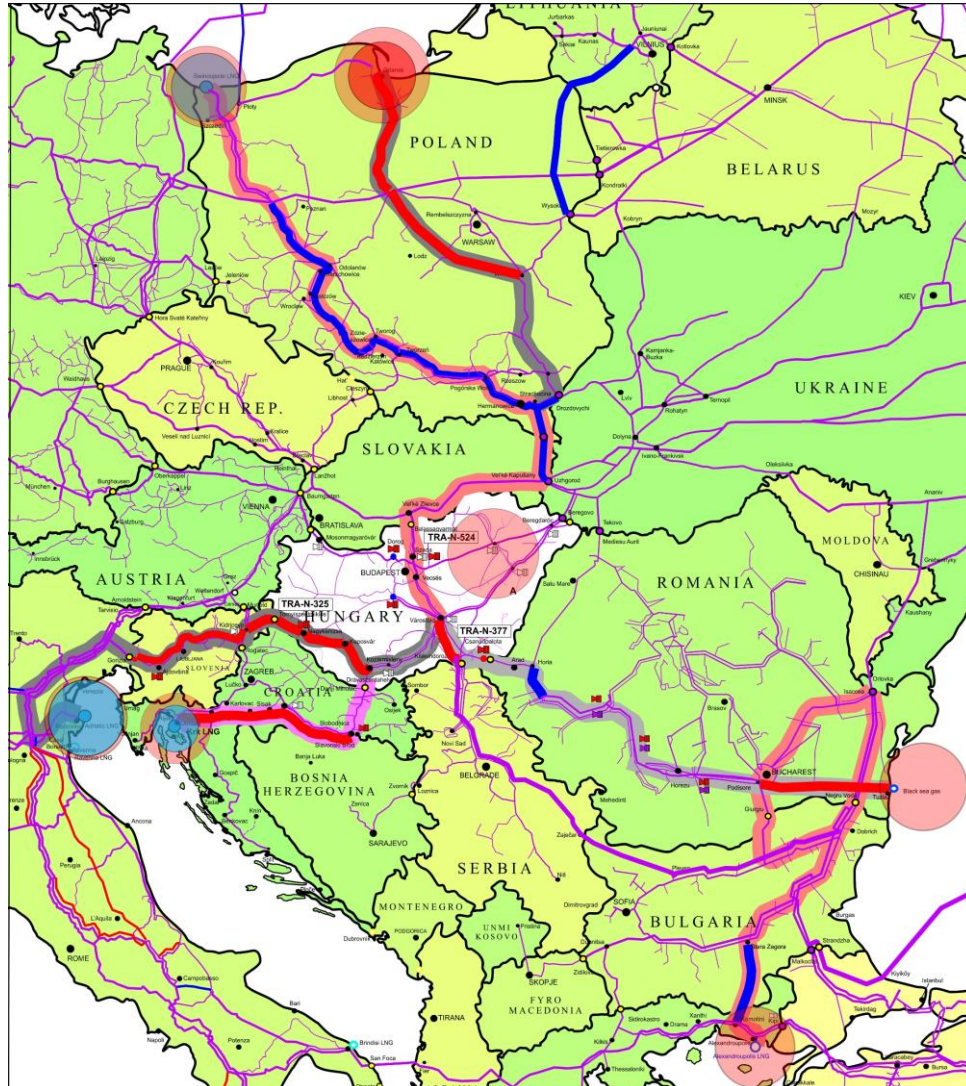


Hungary factsheet

Characteristics of the CEE region



- **Important role of natural gas** in the energy mix
 - Coal-to-gas switch has not finished
 - Low level of domestic gas production
 - **High import need**
 - Historic heritage: East-West supply routes
 - In most cases **high Russian import exposure**
 - Only a **few alternative supply options** with limited capacity
 - Internal bottlenecks and capacity limitations
 - **Landlocked countries especially vulnerable**
- ↓
- **~45 bcma source could be missing** from the region without Russian supply
 - **Natural gas infrastructure development is still needed**
