# Reporting obligations

## Treaty – Article 29 (Title III)

- Adopt **Security of Supply Statements** starting one year after the entry into force of the Treaty
  - for the Parties to the Treaty under Title III – since 1 July 2007
  - for Moldova – since 17 March 2011
  - for Ukraine – since 24 September 2011
  - for Georgia – within one year from the date of accession to the EnC
- Update the Statements and communicate to ECS – **every two years**

## D – 2009/72/EC D – 2009/73/EC

- Ensure monitoring of security of **electricity and gas supply**
- **Publish a report** and forward it to ECS **by 31 July**
  - for **electricity** [Directive 2009/72/EC, Article 4] – **every two years**
  - for **natural gas** [Directive 2009/73/EC, Article 5] – **each year**

## MC Decision 2012/03/MC – EnC D – 2009/119/EC

- Ensure monitoring of **supply of crude oil and petroleum products**
- Included into the Security of Supply Statement - since October 2012
  - for **oil products** [MC Decision 2012/03/MC - EnC] – **every two years**
