

- Amendments to energy/RE legislation to introduce renewable energy auctions
 FYR of MK, MD, MO, UKR
- ✓ Policy Guidelines on competitive selection and support for renewable energy (with EBRD, IRENA)
- Contractual agreements on granting the support part of the auction docs
- ✓ Policy Guidelines on grid integration of prosumers (ECDSO-E)
- Promotion of citizen-owned renewable energy projects (BiH, RS)
- Legal recommendations for community energy in BiH acts;
- Business models for community projects (5 types in BiH)





- ✓ Second progress report on the promotion of RES submitted to the MC in 2017;
- Third Progress reports of CPs due by 31 December 2018;
- Administrative barriers have been addressed and the procedures were streamlined
- Connection procedures have been and balancing responsibility gradually introduced
- Slow progress on sustainable biofuels
- No progress on cooperation mechanisms due to uncertainty of energy data and no clarity on penalty mechanism for not reaching the target





- Study for the 2030 targets has been launched, work to be finalised by June 2019;
- Upon the adoption by the EU of the recast of Renewable Energy Directive (RED II), the process of adaptation for the Energy Community will start

- Partnering and coordination of assistance to the Contracting Parties with EBRD, EIB, KfW, GIZ, GGF, the World Bank,
- Partner in AURES II project;

Next steps





- Extension of the Work Programme until 2020;
- Adaptation of the task, milestones and deadlines for each core topic to match the current progress and to correspond to a realistic schedule;
- Strengthening the legal framework to enable successful auctions and bankable projects;
- Implementation of self-consumption
- Common activities with Working Group on Energy Statistics to ensure accurate and reliable biomass data with a view to determine sound basis for 2030 targets;
