Work-stream 1:


- Market Monitoring Report on the functioning of gas and electricity retail markets
 - 3 detailed questionnaires prepared (electricity, gas and customer protection)
 - NRAs to complete questionnaire May 2018
 - Preliminary results to be discussed in June 2018
- Inputs and support to ACER's gas and electricity retail market monitoring activity
 - Breakdown of household prices based on retail offers
 - Data collection in the final stage

Work-stream 2:

- Assessment paper on NRAs' capacities and processes in retail market monitoring
 - Draft questionnaire to be discussed

TF2: Distribution Tariff Methodologies





Survey of distribution tariff methodology in electricity and gas sectors

- Technological and legislative changes
- New tasks for DSOs
- Implications for the distribution tariffs
- Methodologies applied to be analyzed (including the composition of allowed revenues and tariff design/structures)
- Good practices to be identified + recommendations
- Scope of work agreed, draft questionnaire presented (approval pending), to be completed in May 2018
- Preliminary findings to be discussed during the next CRM WG meeting
