RELEVANT LEGAL ACTS FOR MC 2021 ADOPTION

- **Electricity Directive** 2019/944
- **Electricity Regulation** 2019/943
- **Risk Preparedness Regulation** 2019/941
- **Electricity Guidelines**
 - Regulation (EU) 2015/1222 establishing a guideline on capacity allocation and congestion management (CACM)
 - Regulation (EU) 2016/1719 establishing a guideline on forward capacity allocation (FCA)

IN DETAIL – MC 2021

1. Adoption of Treaty reforms

- Leading to reciprocity and ACER competences for the following legal acts
 - Electricity Directive 2019/944
 - Electricity Regulation 2019/943
 - Electricity Guidelines CACM, FCA, SO, EB
 - Electricity Network Code on emergency and restoration

2. Adoption of the adapted CACM and FCA Guidelines

3. Adoption of 3 annexes defining

- CCRs
- RCCs
- SORs

4. Adoption of the adapted Risk Preparedness Regulation

5. Adoption of the SO and EB Guidelines in a next step

ADAPTATION CONCEPT

- **Electricity Guidelines**
 - “take it or leave it” for existing methodologies – no re-negotiation for CPs
 - FCA
 - single platform obligatory for CPs, option for MSs and 3rd countries (TK!) to participate
 - SEE CAO can (!) be the single platform – but subject to complying with the FCA requirements
- **Risk Preparedness Regulation**
 - References to the Electricity Coordination Group are replaced by the Energy Community’s Security of Supply Coordination Group
 - already adopted methodologies developed pursuant to Article 5 and 8 of Regulation (EU) 2019/941 are considered applicable in the Energy Community
