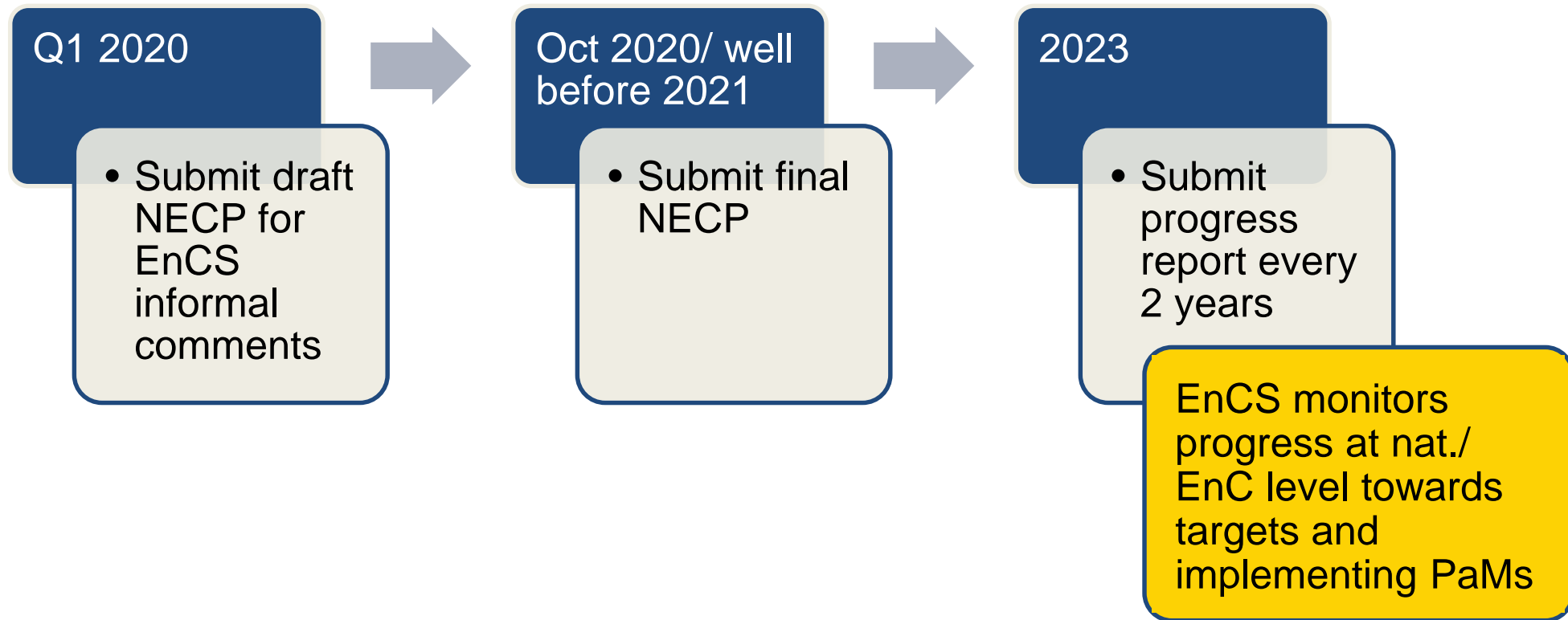
(from 2023, every two years)

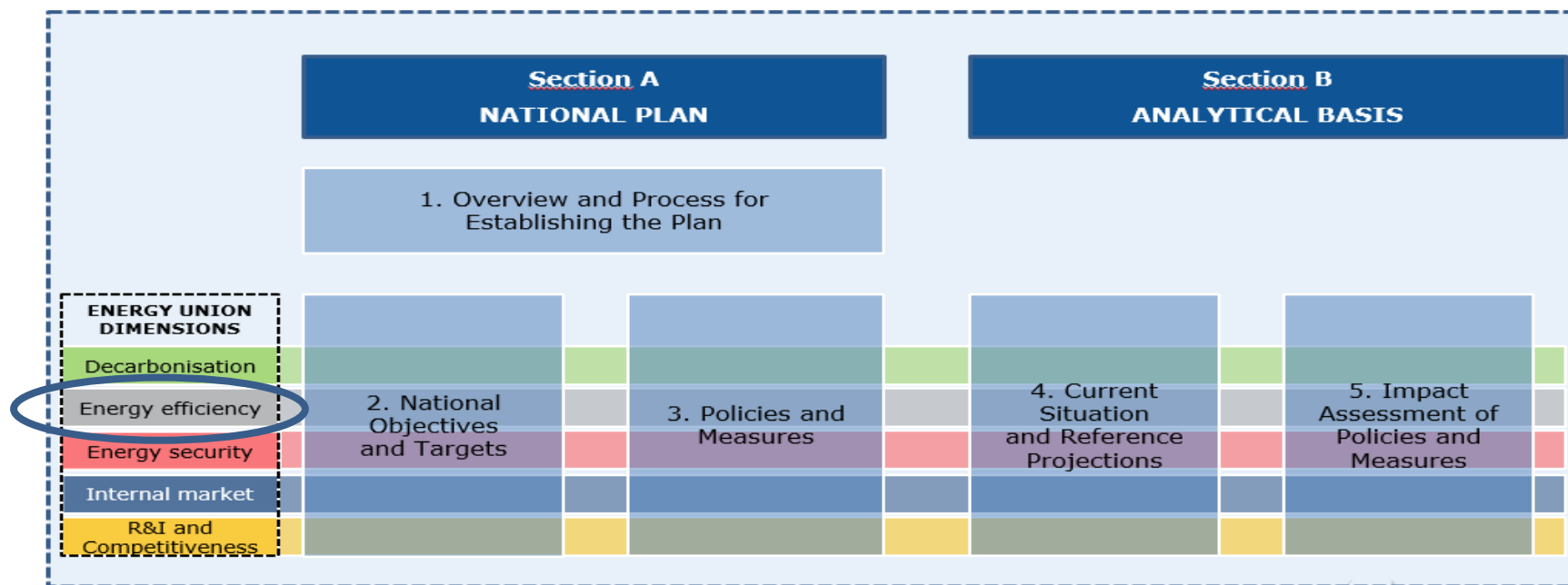

NECPS AND OTHER CLIMATE RELATED PLANNING PROCESSES

Existing sector strategies (e.g. **NEEAP**, NREAP, CAP, NCCAP) should feed into the National Energy and Climate Plan (NECP) which can then inform the update of the Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC)

Dimensions of the National Energy and Climate Plan (NECP)

Prepared for 2020 or future iterations

1 Energy security, solidarity and trust

2 A fully integral energy market

3 Energy efficiency

4 Decarbonisation of the economy

- Policies and measures related to the reduction of GHG emissions to meet 2030 targets for the Energy Community and the Nationally Determined Contributions (NDC).
- Outlook for becoming a low carbon economy in 2050.

5 Research, innovation and competitiveness

LESSON LEARNED: EU MS EXPERIENCES

- ☀ EU MSs had to submit their final NECPs to the EU Commission by the end of 2019, therefore some experiences can be drawn from those.
- ☀ Group I: NEEAPs discussed in their NECPS
 - ☀ MSs discuss some aspects of their last NEEAP in the NECP the following way:
 - ☀ Data to be used as a baseline;
 - ☀ Measures to be taken into account;
 - ☀ Measures to be continued;
 - ☀ Examples: FI, HR.
- ☀ Group II: EE fully integrated in the NECPS
 - ☀ MS do not reference their previous NEEAPs:
 - ☀ EE aspect is fully integrated in the NECPS;
 - ☀ No 2020 targets, etc. mentioned;
 - ☀ Examples: AT, SK.
- ☀ Both approaches can be accepted when submitting final NECPs to the Secretariat for review!
