Progress with transposition of energy efficiency requirements – Clean Energy Package

Law No. 05/L-081 on Energy

Amended and supplemented with an article in which energy saving measures are foreseen in emergency situations.

The new Energy Efficiency Law

The initial draft is ready.

Law on Energy Performance of Buildings

Waiting for approval by the Parliament.

National Energy and Climate Plan

The draft was sent to the secretariat within the deadline. SEA in the process.

National Action Plan for Energy Efficiency (NAPEE) 2022– 2025

Internal consultation phase is done. The document is expected to be released for public consultation soon.

Plan to Increase the Number of NZEB-2022-2024

In the process of drafting.

Building Renovation Strategy

A draft has been prepared by the Ministry of Economy, but the same needs to be harmonized with the new Energy Strategy, and other documents.

Energy labeling and Ecodesign regulation

With the support of REEP-Plus we drafted the Energy Labelling and Eco-design Regulations, only for lighting. A training workshop was held for inspectorate staff and suppliers in Kosovo, to familiarize them with the new regulatory framework.

Ongoing and planned energy efficiency and demand reduction measures

Energy Support Package – 75 million euros

Under this package, the 3rd measure is implemented by KEEF: Support of individual family consumers, including consumers in need by increasing energy efficiency in residential units and buildings (20 million euros)

For multi-apartment buildings, 28/29 applications are proceeded, whereas for the residential sector, 3313 applications were received and in the process of evaluation.

Whereas, measures 4 and 5 are implemented by ME:

4. Supporting household consumers, including consumers in need of investment in efficient home appliances and renewable energy systems (10 million euros).

Around 17,000 applications were received since the first launch in August 2023 and are in the process of evaluation.

5. Encouraging energy savings by Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) (5 million euros)

The public calls for this measure are expected to be released within November 2023.

Expansion and rehabilitation of the heating network KfW - 18.7 million euros

From this expansion project, 6,684 customers have been added so far, the project is still ongoing. The total number of consumers connected to the network is 20,567 consumers.

Prishtina heat save (2023) - installation of district heating meters – 11.7 million euros

The project includes installation of heating meters for up to 17,500 customers of district heating in Prishtina. The project is ongoing and it is foreseen to lower the heating consumption up to 30%. It has not yet been completed - the testing has begun in October 15, 2023, therefore an analysis on saving thermal energy is expected by the end of the season.

KEEREP-Implementation of EE Measures in public buildings, package 6 – 2.8 million euros

Project includes EE measures in 12 central public buildings. The first Lot with 6 public buildings has started the implementation, while lot 2 is in the process of tendering.
