The potential of “Just Transition”/ “Just Transition” initiatives

- As a contracting party of the Energy Community, Moldova is not yet obliged to transpose the Clean Energy Package into national law. There are still many commitments and goals that Moldova has to achieve;
- The Ministry of Economy and Infrastructure plans to amend the Law on Electricity, which would include some elements of the clean energy package. These elements could be implemented today;
- The next key item on the agenda of the Ministry of Economy and Infrastructure is to amend Moldova's Energy Strategy 2030. The Ministry should set new national targets - taking into account the commitments made under the Paris Agreement.



The potential of “Just Transition”/ “Just Transition” initiatives

- The current legislation has allowed to initiate and implement various projects related to renewables;
- In 2020, the "fixed tariff" support scheme was implemented. Based on this support scheme, 27 electricity producers will benefit from State support.
- Over 250 consumers are currently using the net metering mechanism. Their share is increasing rapidly from year to year.
