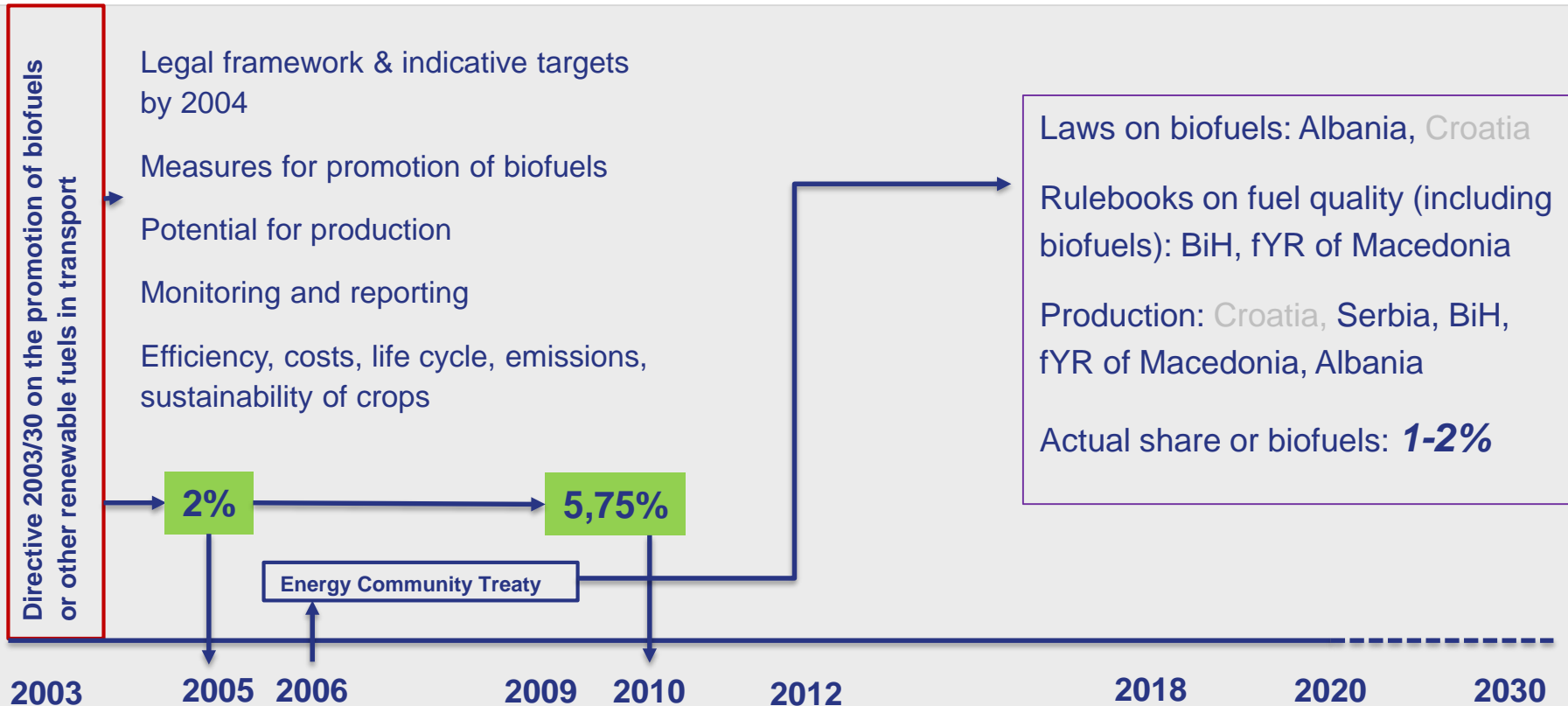

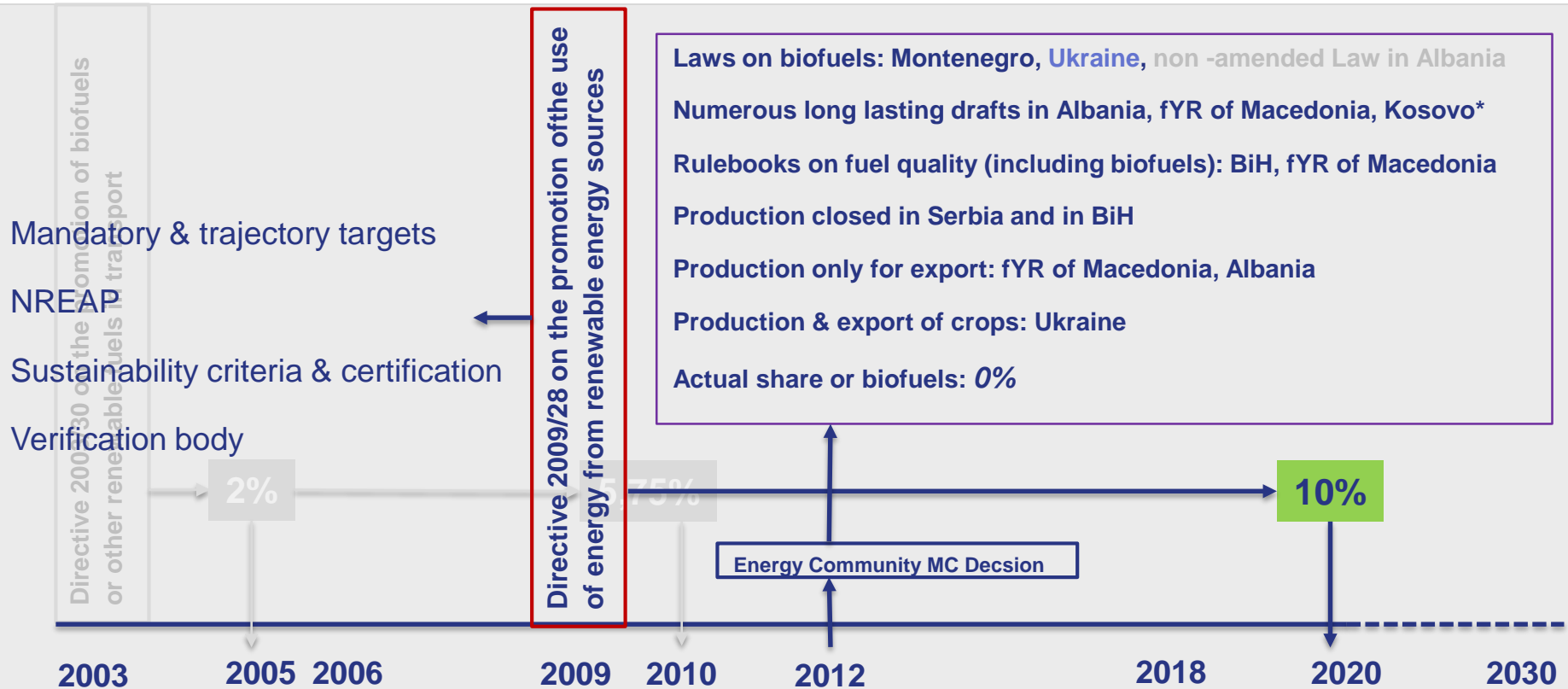

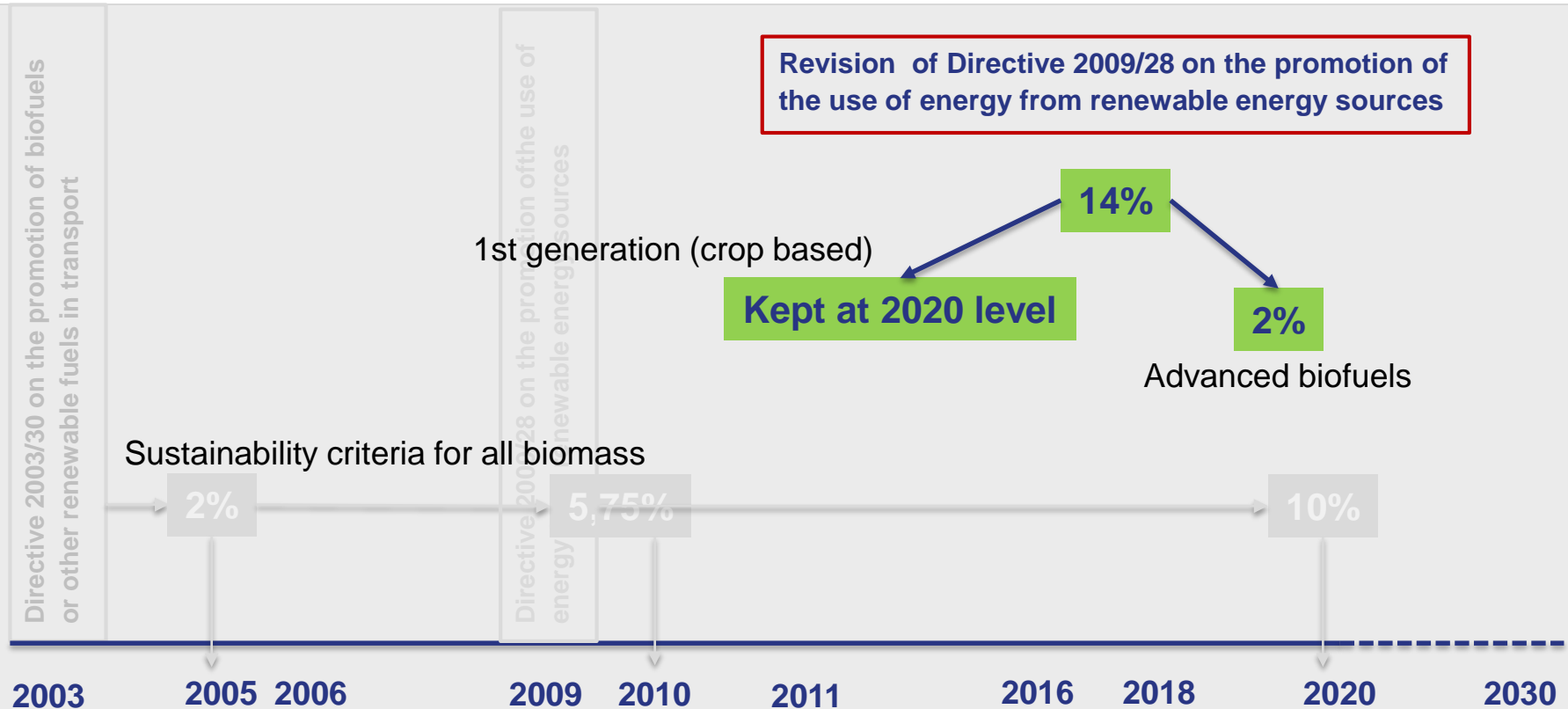

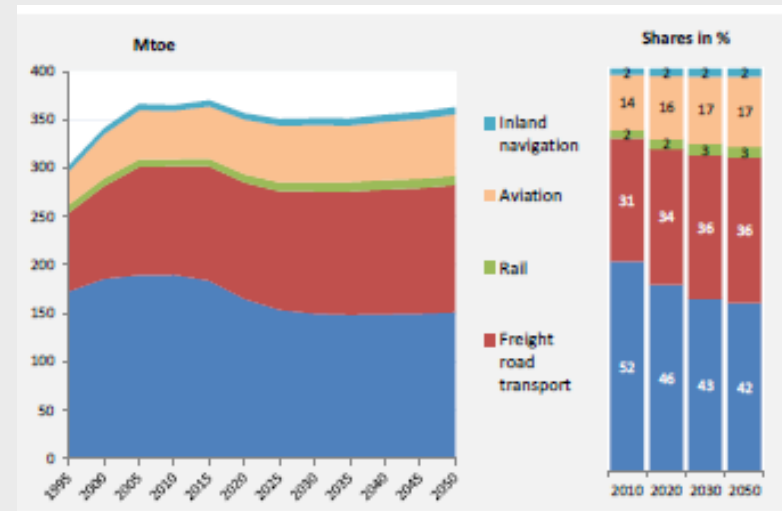
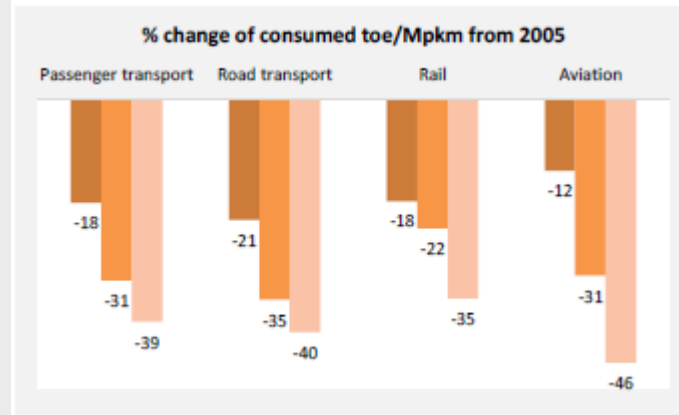
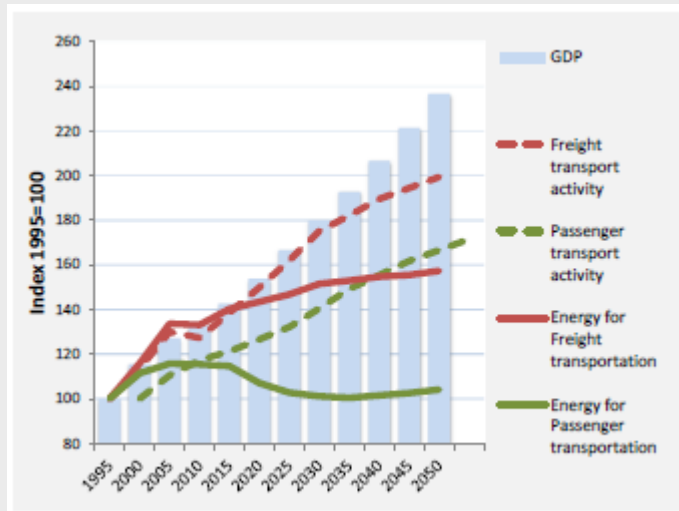

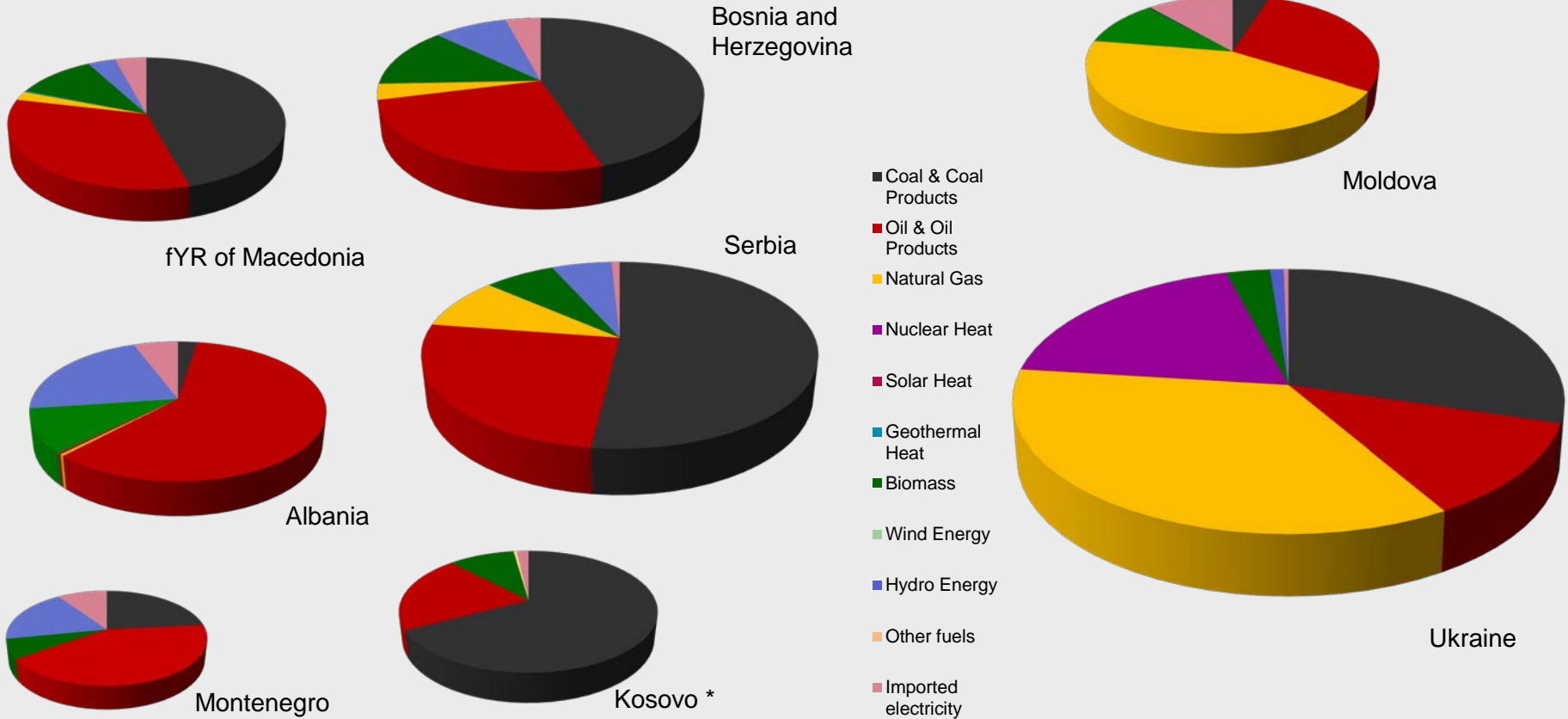


Transport sector in future
