'Sustainable Energy Days' initiative The European Sustainable Energy Week's (EUSEW) 'Sustainable Energy Days' initiative is designed to bring various events organised by stakeholders under the umbrella of the EUSEW community. The purpose is to increase visibility and promote synergy between the individual initiatives and the overarching goals of the European Sustainable Energy Week.

The <u>Energy Community</u> (EnC) is an international organisation which brings together the EU and its neighbours to create an integrated pan-European energy market. It was founded in 2005 by the Treaty establishing the Energy Community. The key objective of the EnC is to extend the EU internal energy market rules and principles to South East Europe, the Black Sea region and beyond on the basis of a legally binding framework.
