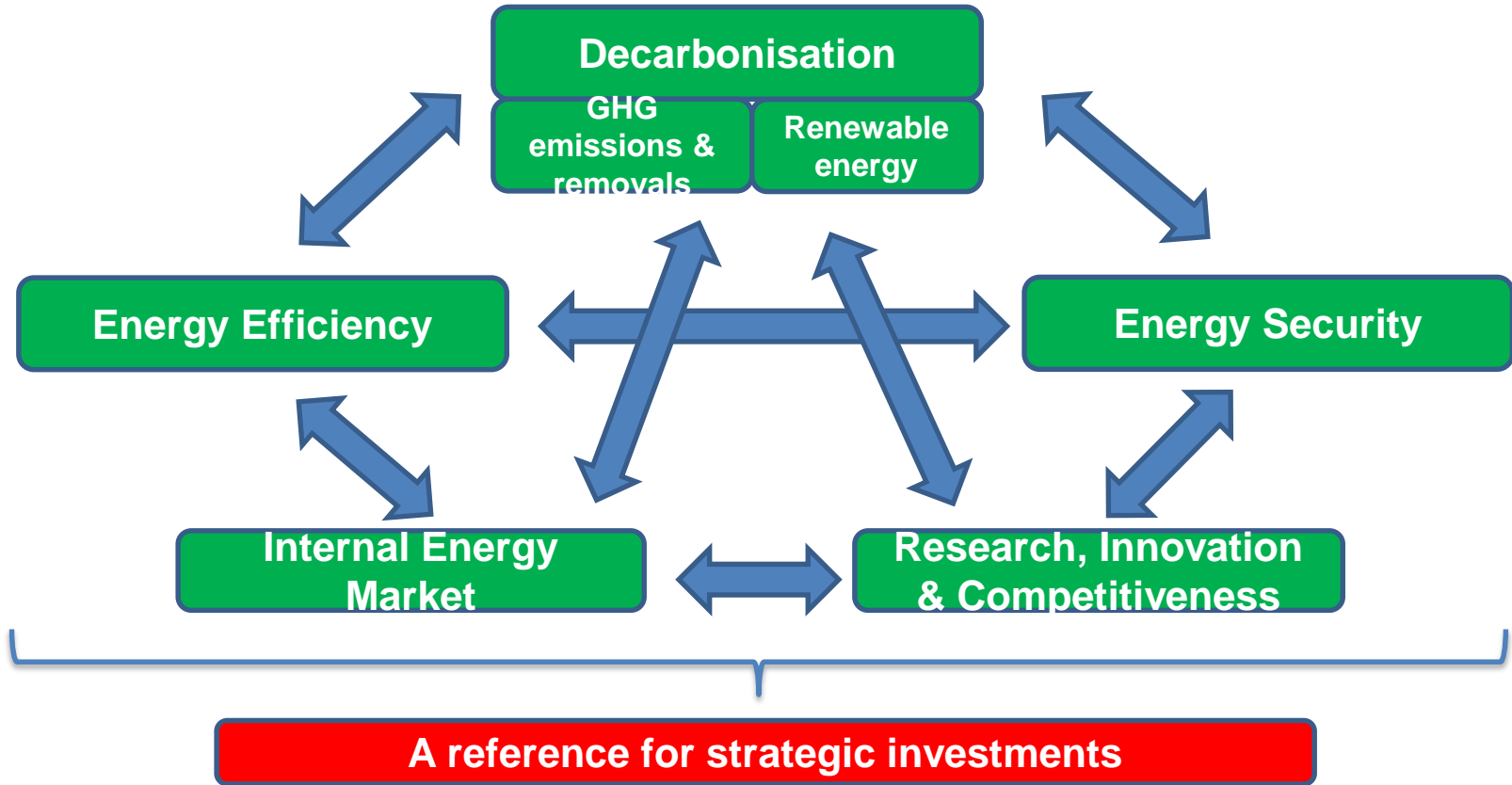

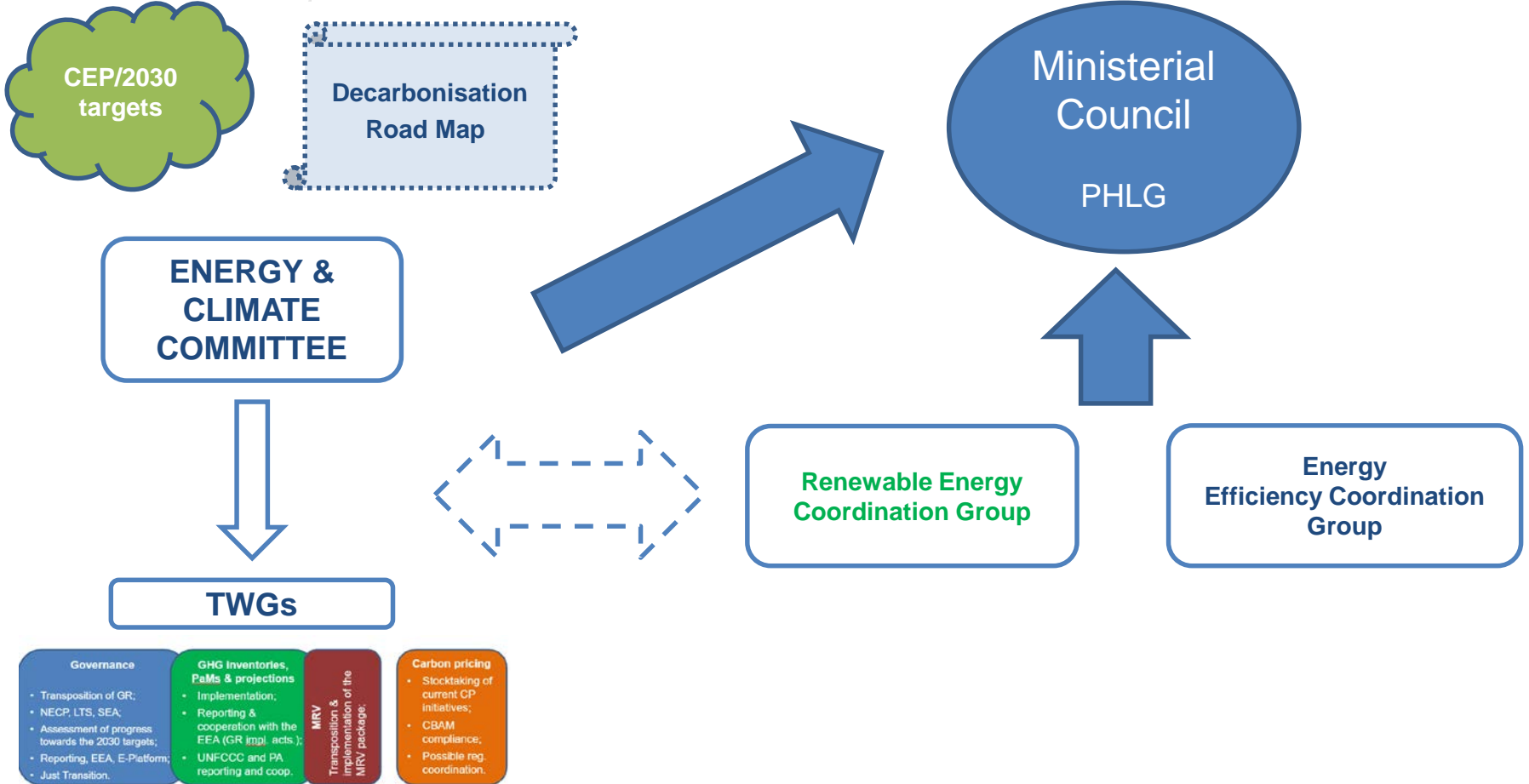
## NECP timeline

# Challenges ahead of RES

- **Transposition and implementation of Clean Energy Package [LEGAL]**
- **Reduction of barriers [PERMITTING]**
- **Market based support schemes [LINK WITH THE PROGRESS ON ELECTRICITY MARKET']**
- **Concept of a comprehensive energy transition of the sector to be based on environmental and climate sustainability – comprehensive vision to be translated into NECPs with a focus of a decarbonization role of RES across different sectors [HEATING!]**
- **Enhanced coordination of energy system planning – local/national/regional**
- **Inclusivity through consumer empowerment:**
  - **self-consumption**
  - **Energy communities**
  - **further push for the enabling framework at the regional level, including through tracking and valorisation of RES attributes [GoOs]**
