








- North Macedonia: Two EPBD Rulebooks under review by Secretariat for Legislation
- Bosnia and Herzegovina: Workshop planned for training of market inspectors on implementation of eco-design and energy labeling rulebooks
- Serbia: Rulebooks drafted for monitoring and verification of cumulative savings per EED Article 7
- ✓ Kosovo: Scoping of Fiscal scheme to support energy efficiency

New assignments

- Montenegro: Heating & Cooling Strategy
- Ongoing conversations for potential new assignments with Albania and Kosovo

Residential (existing Facility) - New signings:

Albania – PCBA; BiH – MiBospo + 1,088 new sub-loans + EUR 7.22m

<u>New Facility: WBGEFF III - REpower</u>

<u>Residential</u> (up to EUR 280m finance facility) approved by EBRD Board in September.

- WBGEFF III will have more focus on residential RE investments together with EE.
- First signing is expected in Q1 2023.

Public buildings

- Signed in Kosovo: Pristina Public Buildings EUR 5m (April'22), Prizren Public Buildings EUR 5m (May'22). Preparations underway for commencement of implementation.
- ✓ Preparations progressing for new projects:
 - SRB: Vojvodina (80 buildings), EUR 14m (expected signing in December'22)
 - BiH: Tuzla EUR 10m

District Heating – projects in preparation

- ✓ SRB: Novi Sad DH EUR 30m
- ✓ SRB: Serbia Renewable District Energy Programme EUR 30m
- ✓ BiH: Zenica District Heating EUR 8m
- ✓ BiH: Sarajevo District Heating EUR 16m project
- ✓ BiH: Pale District Heating EUR 10m

Public buildings

 ✓ MNE: Tenders for two clusters (four buildings) are ongoing, works expected in Q1/2023

KFW

- MNE NZEB: TA ongoing, new building and location to be selected instead of the Ministerial complex in Podgorica
- ✓ NMK: Tender for two student dormitories is ongoing, works expected in early 2023
- ✓ ALB: Tender for five buildings is completed, preaward discussions are ongoing, works expected in mid-December 2022

District Heating

- SRB Biomass: preparation of the second phase of the ongoing Biomass programme is underway, appraisal mission conducted in October 2022, contract signing expected in mid-2023
- ✓ SRB Solar DH: two cities shortlisted, preparation of PFSs in progress







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
