

- Additional information for consumers
- Replacing previous
   (A+++ to D) with a
   redesigned and
   rescaled (A to G) labels
- CPs are following those changes on voluntary basis

#### Relevant legislative acts

- Regulation (EU) 2019/2013 on energy labelling of electronic displays
- Regulation (EU) 2019/2014 on energy labelling for household washing machines and washer-dryers
- Regulation (EU) 2019/2015 on energy labelling for light sources
- Regulation (EU) 2019/2016 on energy labelling for refrigerating appliances
- Regulation (EU) No 1059/2017 on energy labelling for household dishwashers

#### General approach applicable to all legal acts

• Standard adaptations: MS → CP, etc.

- Specific adaptations for discussion:
  - No access to EPREL relevant articles deleted/changed e.g. technical documentation is made available directly at the request of the market surveillance authorities
  - No EU flag treatment of "EnC only" suppliers (incl. label) e.g. update labels with CP flags
  - Transposition deadline: 31 December 2023



#### **Tentative Timeline**

- **EECG March 2021**: Rescaling of Energy Labels and new EU regulation
- EECG Nov 2021: Plan for adoption of products labelling regulations
- **EECG March 2022**: Progress with the transposition of labelling framework
- PHLG April 2022: New products labelling regulations proposal for 2022 adoption
- Discussion, finalisation and adoption for PHLG / MC 2022
