



- Amendments to energy/RE legislation to introduce renewable energy auctions – N.Macedonia, MD, MO, UKR
- ✓ Implementation of the Policy Guidelines on competitive selection and support for renewable energy (with EBRD assistance, Albania, Moldova, N. Macedonia, Serbia)
- Contractual agreement on granting the support
- ✓ Implement the Policy Guidelines on grid integration of prosumers (ECDSO-E) and develop self-consumption rules
- Promotion of citizen-owned renewable energy projects (examples in BiH, RS)
- Legal recommendations for community energy
- Business models for community projects (5 types in BiH)





- Third Progress reports of CPs due by 31 December 2018 – Albania, Kosovo\*, Serbia and Ukraine submitted
- Third EnC progress report on the promotion of RES submitted to the MC by 30 June 2019
- To address the administrative barriers and streamline the procedures in auction process
- To address the issues with connection procedures and balancing responsibility where applicable
- Advance and progress on sustainable biofuels
- Identify possibility for cooperation mechanisms – more accuracy and certainty with the energy data and clarity on penalty mechanism for not reaching the target





- Study for the 2030 targets has been launched, work to be finalised by June 2019
- Methodology to calculate the 2030 RES targets convergent with EU ambition to be presented and agreed
- Secretariat started the process of adaptation of the recast of Renewable Energy Directive (RED II), for the Energy Community





- Workshops to be organised in cooperation with IRENA and other relevant organisations
- Partnering and coordination of assistance to the Contracting Parties with EBRD, EIB, KfW, GIZ, GGF, the World Bank,
- Partner in AURES II project – assistance to Ukraine and possible to other CPs;

- Agreement on the Work Programme until 2020;
- Tasks, milestones and deadlines for each core topic were adapted to match the current progress and to correspond to a realistic schedule;
- Strengthening the legal framework to enable successful auctions and bankable projects;
