 - introducing a new approach in the manner of implementing the responsibilities of the Energy Regulatory Commission. In order to bring the whole process closer to the consumers and to present the Electricity market rules in more detail, as well as the new pricing regulation, eight workshops were organized for the companies that, as consumers of electricity, first met the criteria for free electricity market participation (more of fifty (50) employees and total annual income or total assets of more than ten (10) million euros),
 - active involvement in resolving all problems faced by free electricity market participants, primarily technical issues (problems with meters, unclear property rights related to the connection of several customers, etc.), and actively strives to ensure fair and equal conditions for all suppliers participating in the free electricity market,
 - protection consumer rights and advocates for uninterrupted power supply;
8. Giving opinion on papers regarding the development of the Regional Energy Market in South East Europe within the Electricity Working Group (ECRB Electricity Working Group);
9. Coordinator of the working groups for determination of regulated maximum income, tariffs for performing regulated energy activities in the field of electricity:
 - analysis of the data submitted by all regulated companies,
 - independent development of a model for calculation of regulated income, final prices and tariffs of regulated companies in the field of electricity,
 - insertion of data in an appropriate model for calculation of regulated income, final prices and tariffs of regulated utilities in the field of electricity;
10. Preparation of the Rulebooks for determination of feed-in tariffs for electricity produced from renewable energy sources;
11. Participating in the operation of the ECRB working groups: ECRB EWG, ECRG CWG, SEE CAO IG;
12. Member of the working group for drafting the Law on Energy;
13. Responsible for several international projects in the Energy Regulatory Commission of the Republic of Macedonia (twinning project with the Austrian Energy Regulator and technical assistance for the preparation of electricity price regulation financed by the European Commission and the project for institutional strengthening of the Energy Regulatory Commission for fulfilment of obligations arising from the new Energy Law, financed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Norway)
