# Transposition

- Deadline for transposition is 31 Dec 2023
- High number of legal acts including new content → activities need to be started asap
- CPs were asked to fill a table on the national status quo and already available assistance for the upcoming activities
- TAIEX (EC) provides assistance for WB6 + EU4Energy covers GE, MD and UA
  - Assistance to CPs for the transposition of the new electricity package throughout this year
  - TAIEX envisages regional workshops and dedicated support/country missions for each CP WB6
  - TAIEX kick-off (3/4 April, Vienna) introduces content of legal acts adopted (for all CPs)
  - EU4Energy will cover dedicated support/country missions for GE, MD and UA
- EnCS is ready to provide additional support for CPs if needed

# Implementation

- First deadlines for implementation are already due this year (e.g. designation of Nominated Electricity Market Operators, capacity calculation).
- EnCS prepared a set of roadmaps indicating the most important milestones (to be published on the homepage after this meeting):
  - one general overview (excel) for the next three years and
  - specific roadmaps for each legal act.
- EnCS will continue support:
  - a first webinar on the new electricity package was held at the beginning of February
  - several workshops/webinars for stakeholders of CPs to be organized in 2023 – the first one on market coupling will take place on 16 May in Vienna
