## ❖ Why?

### TEST

The coordination and communication between the ECS, CPs and other stakeholders – i.e. the process

### SIMULATE

The possible impact of a disruption scenario and the implementation of national measures – i.e. the content

### EVALUATE

The effectiveness of cooperation, the strengths and the possibilities for improvement

## ❖ When?

- Early 2019 (concrete day tbc)

## ❖ How?

- Based on a scenario with pre-defined conditions (temperatures, flows, storage levels etc.)
- Real-life simulation i.e. participants at their own desks, contacts via phone, unforeseen developments etc.
