50% of households cannot afford sufficient warmth- Kosovo*

37 square meter of heated space per household- FYROM

January 2017 mortality higher 50% than January 2016 mortality- Serbia

Largest share of households with central heating installations in the region: 38.4 % - Serbia


15% of households with central heating installations- Albania

More than 67% of all households in the region use solid fuels OR fuel wood for heating (fuel wood and coal are jointly presented as solid fuel in some national statistics)



Shares of fuels in household energy consumption






Fuel poverty and energy poverty widespread

Efficiency in real life 32.59%




Results from two Serbian regions.
