EECG WORK PROGRAMME 2017-2018

- ***WP INCLUDES 4 AREAS AND 10 CORE TOPICS, CONTINUES THE WORK OF THE EECG 2015-2016***
- ***SUMMARY PRESENTED AND DRAFT PUBLISHED (NOVEMBER 2016)***
 - CPs invited to comment on the Work Programme (esp. CT Leaders) - December 2016
 - Donors/IFIs invited to check WP and send proposal for (additional) support to the EECG related to the Work Programme - by the same date
- ***FOCUS: Directive 2012/27 EU, implementation of NEEAPs and their monitoring, promotion of the exemplary role of public sector and energy services, coordination of donors support for energy efficiency, promotion of existing support initiatives (REEP Plus, WB6 Sustainability Charter etc.) and design of new ones.***
- ***FOLLOWS EXAMPLE OF EU CONCERTED ACTIONS TO SUPPORT THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF EED, EPBD AND ELD***
- ***FLEXIBLE: IT MAY INCLUDE OTHER ACTIVITIES ARISING FROM THE EXTENSION OF THE ENC TREATY***

 - ▶ **Core Topics Leaders:** coordinate implementation of respective WP Core Topics, prepare sessions and discussions, summarise key findings and recommendations during the EECG meetings and on Web Forum (with ECS support);

- Analysis of new EU policy requirements and recommendations (incl. 2030 framework)
- Strengthening of national institutions for energy efficiency
- Consumer information programmes, training and education; exchange of best implementation practices in CPs and EU (EECG meetings, WEB Forum)
- Promotion of existing support initiatives and design of new ones (financial instruments and information actions, transport sector tariff reform etc.)
- Coordination of donors support on energy efficiency: EU/ IPA/EU4Energy, World Bank, GIZ, EBRD, USAID, WB6 Sustainability Charter etc.
- Development of energy efficiency statistics and indicators
