Security of Supply - Impact assessment



Bosnia and Herzegovina	100%
Georgia	15%
North Macedonia	100%
Moldova	100%
Serbia	88%
Ukraine	0%

- Impact assessment for Contracting Parties in case of halt of the Russian supplies (also with ENTSOG)
- Risks per Contracting Party Moldova most vulnerable
- Ukraine
- WB CPs
- Georgia low risk
- Infrastructure bottlenecks, demand response, potential alternative supplies; risks for electricity
- Regulatory set ups and measures to be implemented to mitigate risks
- Demand assessment (gas, heat, EL) under the Energy Platform/regional initiative

Transposition of Regulation 2017/1938 on gas SoS coincides with new storage amendment



Storage amendments mirror the EU (recently adopted) amendment

Matter of urgency

Filling targets for this autumn already proposed – (1 Sept, 1 Oct, 1 Nov 2022) Serbia, Ukraine; sunset clause: 31.12.2025

Derogation for Georgia, MNE, Kos*


CPs without storages – burden sharing mechanisms
