





Flow observations in January 2023







- Storage: relatively low usage of UGS
 - Injections during Christmas/New Year period
- East corridor:
 - TurkStream: lower flows
 - Ukraine: lower flows
- Norwegian corridor: stable
- North African corridor: stable, lower flows in January
- UK corridor: lower flows to the EU
- LNG corridor: high flows
 - New LNG terminals in Germany and Finland
- Caspian corridor: stable flows (slight lower flows in January)
- Other observations:
 - Nominations from EU to Ukraine and Moldova
- Lower gas consumption in 2023 vs. 2022(2021)

Flows to the EU






January 2023



EU Gas Storage filling levels on 29 January 2023 vs. 2022









Filling Levels by Years

ENTSOG and TSOs other SoS activities



- TSOs continue morning calls (Mon, Wed, Fri) and monitoring the flows patterns and market behavior
- Incidents and coordination between TSOs
 - 20 December incident in Russia on one of transit pipelines
 - Information sharing with the EC
 - No SoS impact
- 13 January incident in Lithuania
 - Coordination between TSOs in the Baltic Region
 - ENTSOG in close contact with Ambergrid
 - Information sharing with the EC
 - No SoS impact
- New TTX in February (full RU supply disruption + 1 extra event)
