Regulatory Developments in the Montenegrin Energy Sector

43rd ECRB meeting, Athens, 9 October 2019



State Level

The Government has adopted three Regulations:

- Commission Regulation 2016/1388 of establishing a Network Code on Demand Connection ("Official Gazette of Montenegro" No. 28/19 of 23 May 2019),
- Commission Regulation (Eu) 2016/1447 of establishing a network code on requirements for grid connection of high voltage direct current systems and direct current-connected power park modules ("Official Gazette of Montenegro" No. 28/19 of 23 May 2019)
- Commission Regulation (Eu) 2016/631 of establishing a network code on requirements for grid connection of generators modules ("Official Gazette of Montenegro" No. 43/19 of 31 July 2019)



- Amendment to the Energy Law are planned by the end of 2019.
- Supplier of last resort and vulnerable customers has been chosen



Activities within the Agency

- The Report on situation in the energy sector of Montenegro for 2018 was adopted in the end of April
- The Financial Report with the Report on the Work of the Energy Regulatory Agency for 2020 has been adopted and submitted to the Ministry of finance
- Consideration of the applications of the transmission system operator, distribution system operator and market operator for regulatory allowed revenue are in progress
- The Training Course on Electricity Markets and Trading was held in Podgorica
