Normative acts to be prepared and adopted according to Georgian Law on Energy Efficiency - status as of November 17, 2021

- **The three by laws are already drafted – soon to be adopted**
 - Rule of reporting on achieving the indicative national energy efficiency target;
 - Rule of cost-benefit analysis of heating and cooling systems;
 - Rule on submitting notification to the Energy Community Secretariat on alternative policy measures and/or on EEOs, determined by the NECP.
- **Drafting is in progress for:**
 - Concept and rule on the registry of the buildings owned and occupied by administrative bodies (public buildings);
 - Rule on mandatory energy audits for the first category enterprises (*initial version is drafted*);
 - Form of the protocol on the imposition of administrative liability under the Law on Energy Efficiency
- **Initial activities are being developing for:**
 - Training programs for providers of Energy Services, Energy Audits in industry, Energy Performance Certificates in buildings, Energy managers and installers of Energy-related building elements;
 - Rules and guidelines on the implementation of Energy Efficiency in the public procurement;
 - National monetary thresholds for energy-efficient public procurement.

Normative acts to be prepared and adopted according to Georgian Law on Energy Efficiency of Buildings- status as of November 17, 2021

- **The two by laws are adopted:**

- National methodology for calculating the energy performance of buildings;
- The minimum energy performance requirements for buildings, building units and building elements.

- Comparative methodology for calculating cost-optimal levels of minimum energy performance requirements for buildings, building units and building elements;
- Rules for development and utilization of one or more energy performance calculating programs/software;
- Rules of selection and installation, regulation and management of engineering-technical support systems taking into account the total energy efficiency of the new/existing buildings;
- Rule of certification for energy performance of buildings.

- Rules of regular inspection of heating and air-conditioning systems.
