Why such an exercise?

1. To test how we communicate with each other;
 2. To test how we can coordinate our measures in a crisis;
 3. To see how the provisions of national emergency plans can be applied in practice;
- +1 To improve in all of the above!

What will it be about? How will it take place?

- ❖ **Topic:** realization of a multi-dimensional risk scenario → imbalance of gas demand and supply;
- ❖ **Tool:** table top exercise
 - ✓ Carried out in a physical setting (in the room);
 - ✓ Participants receive the same personalised, pre-defined scenario with some questions/actions;
 - ✓ Based on the information available;
 - ✓ Discussions taking place in rounds.
- ❖ **Principles:**
 - ✓ Informal, no-risk environment – no good or bad outcome. The aim is to test how processes work;
 - ✓ It is NOT a modelling of gas flows, it is a simulation of how we work together in such a situation;
 - ✓ Be ready for unexpected developments and to adapt your position.
