Wrap-up and closing of the meeting

- Ten nominated electricity projects are eligible for the PECI status and will be analysed further.
- Seven electricity (4) and gas (3) projects are considered as not eligible. Because of a lack of eligible gases related projects, the gasses group will not be invited to the following two meetings.
- Public consultation on eligible projects will be open from 19.4. until 1 May 2024.
- Country-specific data should be delivered within one week at the latest.
- Sensitivities related to CO2 price, load and RES integration will be analysed.
- Draft report on scenarios and data will be distributed until 26 April and final report on scenarios and data will be distributed until 3 May, following the end of public consultation




