ENTSOG Members



- 3 kinds of memberships possible :
- > The full **Members** = EU certified TSOs
 - Represented in the ENTSOG GA (and eligible to the ENTSOG Board)
 - Participation open in the Working Groups ("WGs")
- > The Associated Partners = EU TSOs enjoying derogations & exemptions according to Gas Regulation or Directive 2009/73/EC
 - Represented in the ENTSOG GA without voting rights
 - Participation the Working Groups ("WGs") if granted by the Board
- >The Observers = TSO in a state candidate for accession to the EU, party to the Energy Community or to the convention establishing the European Free Trade Association
 - Represented in the ENTSOG GA without voting rights

> To enhance the transparency of gas TSOs' activities in the European Union.


Key deliverables for 2017

- > To further enhance ENTSOG Transparency Platform with functionalities improving the usability and user-friendliness of the published data, as well as further support the TSOs in improving data consistency.
- > To support the TSOs in the process for implementation of REMIT requirements.
- > To support the ENTSOG strategy for any potential deliverables relating to the transparency area.
- Follow and implement the transparency requirements coming from the Network Codes.

Key deliverables are a small subset of transparency activities
